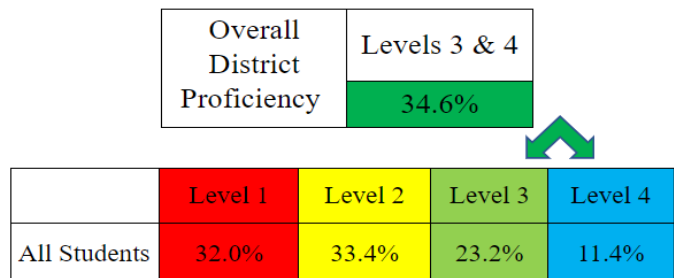

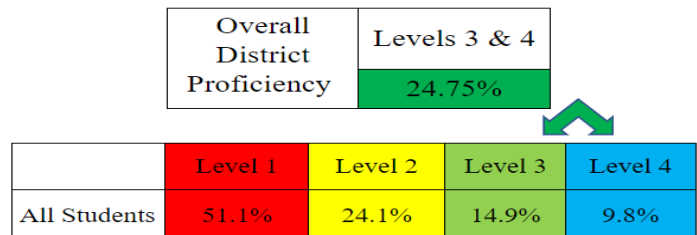
## District 19 NYS ELA 2022 Data
